Supervised Population Workforce Training Program



What is it?

A training and employment program to help the supervised population gain the skills and tools necessary to find and keep a job.

Who is the program for?

ForwardFocus is for anyone eighteen years and older who is on probation, mandatory supervision, or post-release community supervision.

What can the program do for me?

- Career Assessment, including vocational training as applicable based on each individual's career plan.
- Job-seeking assistance including job leads and connections to employers in top industries such as manufacturing, hospitality and tourism, and construction.
- Job retention services and supports.
- Supportive services such as transportation assistance, professional clothing, etc. based on individuals' needs.
- Job readiness workshops to learn necessary skills such as interview techniques, resume writing, and transferrable skills.

How do I get started?

Talk to your probation officer to determine if you are qualified and request to be referred to ForwardFocus.
